## Quinnipiac University to Host Hundreds of High and Middle School Students at 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual Connecticut Science Fair

Nearly 500 middle and high school students from throughout the state will showcase their science talent at the 2010 Connecticut Science Fair. The week-long event will be held March 9-13 at Quinnipiac University in Hamden. **The best opportunity for media to catch the action is during final judging between 8:30 a.m. and 1:15 p.m. on Thursday, March 11, when about 150 student finalists will present their projects to and answer questions from judges from academia and industry.**

The top four winners, (who will represent Connecticut at the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair in San Jose, Calif., May 9-14,) along with winners in other categories will be announced by 5 pm Thursday, March 11. Special Award winners will be announced by noon on Saturday, March 13.
