

2010 Science Fair



2010 REGISTRATION

- Only on-line school registrations are accepted. To register go to: <http://www.ctsciencefair.org>
- School and affiliated fair registration closes October 30.
- Registration will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.
- The number of registrants for each school is limited to: 6 per middle school, 12 per senior high school, or combined middle-senior high schools may enter under both categories accordingly. Assigned quotas will be reviewed at the end of November.
- Student online registration includes: Student/Project Registration, Research Plan, and Release Form.
- Schools may be granted additional registrants at the discretion of the registration chairman.
- Students may compete in only one Intel International Science and Engineering Fair affiliated fair except when proceeding to the state fair from an affiliated fair as a finalist.
- Students from schools not affiliated with the fair and home school students can register directly so long as their online registration submitted by November 15.
- High school students must register their projects with the Fair as soon as they select their project and by no later than December 1.

Exception: High Schools and local fairs registered to qualify entrants to CSF may request an extension that is no later than 10 days after their fair and prior to Feb 15. Send an email to registration@ctsciencefair.org confirming your fair date and agreeing to review all projects in advance and submit any requiring prior approval to the CSF Scientific Review Committee by Dec. 1. This must take place before research begins (unless the research is conducted in a registered research institution setting) or the students will be disqualified. Fairs having Scientific Review Committees in place should contact the CSF Registration Chairman for instructions.

- Middle school student online registration and a signed Release Form must be received within ten business days of the school fair and by no later than February 15.
- All project abstracts must be submitted online by no later than March 1.
- No registrations will be accepted after 8:00 P.M. February 15, 2010 under any circumstances!

All affiliated school fairs must be conducted by February 15, 2010.

2010 CONNECTICUT STATE SCIENCE FAIR REGISTRATION DEADLINES

- October 30, 2009 Last day to submit school registration on-line.
- November 15, 2009 Students unaffiliated with schools: Submit on-line registration with research plan and mail signed release form to Registration Chairman.
- December 1, 2009 Deadline for high school students* (See Below*) to submit on-line registration.
- February 15, 2010, 8:00 PM Online student registration including research plan and release form due from registered schools. No registrations will be accepted after this deadline.
- February 15, 2010 All affiliated school fairs must be conducted.
- March 1, 2010, 8:00 PM Project abstracts must be submitted on-line by this deadline.
- March 10, 2010, 7:30 PM Project check-in completed and signed off by display and safety committee. Hall doors locked at 7:30 PM.

* High Schools and local fairs registered to qualify entrants to CSF may request an extension that is no later than 10 days after their fair and prior to Feb 15. Send an email to registration@ctsciencefair.org confirming your fair date and agreeing to review all projects in advance and submit any requiring prior approval to the CSF Scientific Review Committee by Dec. 1. This must take place before research begins (unless the research is conducted in a registered research institution setting) or the students will be disqualified. If you are called to be present as a Finalist or Special Awards winner your attendance is mandatory. Failure to attend the Finalist or Special Awards functions will result in disqualification. Exceptions are granted for religious observances.
